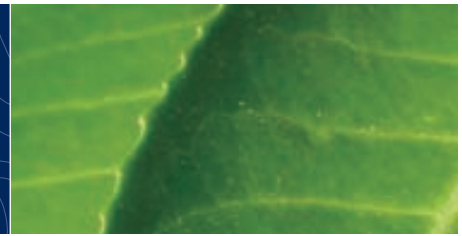


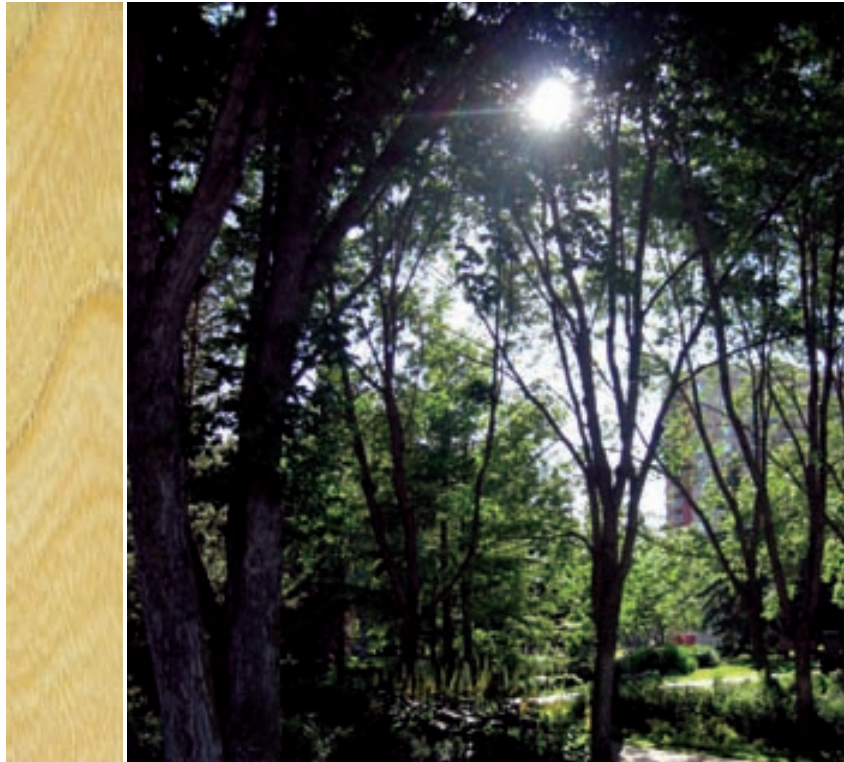


White Elm
